Increase in cargo theft: Reward Offered for \$3M Cargo Theft Fugitive

The FBI is offering a reward of up to \$5,000 for information leading to the arrest and conviction of Yoelvis Denis Hernandez, 42, of Dade County, Florida, for his alleged involvement in the theft of a \$3 million shipment of ventilators on or about August 9, 2020. Anyone with information as to the whereabouts of Hernandez is urged to call 754.703.2000. The ventilators were being shipped to El Salvador by the United States Agency for International Development (USAID) when stolen and were intended to assist the country's response to COVID-19....Read More
